Luke intended his Gospel to be read primarily by a Gentile audience, and he presented Jesus Christ as the Savior of both Jews and Gentiles. Luke specifically addressed His gospel to "Theophilus" ( Luke 1:3 ), which in Greek means "friend of God" or "beloved of God" (see Bible Dictionary, "Theophilus" ). It is apparent that Theophilus had received previous instruction concerning the life and teachings of Jesus Christ (see Luke 1:4 ).

Luke's characteristic themes include: (1) universality, recognition of Gentiles as well as Jews in God's plan (see, e.g., 2:30-32 and notes on 2:31; 3:6); (2) emphasis on prayer, especially Jesus' praying before important occasions (see note on 3:21); (3) joy at the announcement of the gospel or "good news" (see note on 1:14); (4) special concern for the role of women (see, e.g., 8:1-3 and notes); (5) special interest in the poor (some of the rich were included among Jesus' followers, but he ...

Scholars believe this gospel was written by a physician and Christ-follower named Luke, traveling companion of the apostle Paul. While none of the four gospel accounts lists an author, early church leaders attributed this account to Luke, and he is identified by name as among Paul's "fellow workers" with Mark, Aristarchus, and Demas (Philemon 24 NIV).
