Even in cases where a plaintiff is not entitled for injunctive relief, or where a nuisance is not abatable, a plaintiff can recover damages for the injury suffered [i]. Damages can also be recovered for injury resulting from the legal use of a property, if such use substantially damages the property of another [ii].

At common law, damages are a remedy in the form of a monetary award to be paid to a claimant as compensation for loss or injury. To warrant the award, the claimant must show that a breach of duty has caused foreseeable loss. To be recognised at law, the loss must involve damage to property, or mental or physical injury; pure economic loss is rarely recognised for the award of damages.
