However, memory has a use-it-or-lose-it quality: memories that are called up and used frequently are least likely to be forgotten.

Forgetfulness — 7 types of normal memory problems ...

According to the trace decay theory of forgetting, the events that happen between the formation of a memory and the recall of the memory have no impact on recall. Trace theory proposes that the length of time between the memory and recalling that information determines whether the information will be retained or forgotten.
