Seismic monitoring, gas monitoring and deformation studies are the three key areas of monitoring that volcanologists use. Seismic monitoring indicates whether magma is moving within the volcano. Gas monitoring, particularly sulphur dioxide, can tell us about the magma in the volcano. Ground deformation studies can tell us if the volcano is inflating as magma feeds into the volcano or deflating as it drains away.
